Job Title: Cleaner

Job Purpose: To maintain school premises to the required standard of cleanliness. Required

## Main duties and responsibilities:

- 3. To use cleaning materials appropriately and economically, to inform the Business Manager/Site Agent when stocks are low.
- 4. To ensure that tools and equipment are in good working order, reporting any faults to the Site Agent.
- 5. To ensure that Cleaner's/Site Agent store room is kept clean and tidy at all times.
- 6. To undertake any non-routine cleaning tasks as instructed by the Headteacher or authorised staff.
- 7. To work to Council's guidelines at all times particularly in relation to health and safety at work.
- 8. To attend all essential health and safety training courses as determined by the management of the school and/our Council.
- 9. To maintain confidentiality at all times in respect of school related matters and to prevent the disclosure of confidential and sensitive information.
- 10. To undertake any other duties or a similar level of responsibility as may be required.
- 11. To work additional hours to cover periods of absence by the Site Agent and to work additional hours during school holidays as required.
- 12. To adhere to the school's safeguarding procedures at all times and to act as a positive role model in our Values Education Programme.
