We are so pleased to be welcoming all the children back to school on Monday 8th March. It will be so lovely to hear the school busy with children again.

We know that you will be relieved that the children are returning but also maybe some of you will feel anxious about it. As in September when we returned fully to school we will be keeping the safety of the children, staff and parents as our top priority. We are aware that for some children there will be anxieties about returning and that children will all have had different experiences throughout the lockdown.

Drop off and pick up times will remain the same as before Christmas and we will use the one-way system again as the entrance **ONLY**. It is a real safety concern to use both ways due to the lack of space available to pass each other. We know you may feel it is an inconvenience, especially when you are the last year group to leave. We are trying to be fair to all and keep everyone safe. Only those pushing buggies or with disabilities will be allowed to walk back up the slope. You should ensure you adhere to this system at all times. We also request that you wear face coverings on the playground and please exit the site swiftly to avoid making unnecessary contacts with other parents.

If you are just collecting children from year 1-4 please do not arrive on the playground before 3.20pm to allow our other parents to leave. Remember to keep your children with you at all times and not allow children to run out onto the bank by the car park exit. Also remember that other restrictions are still in place and families should not be socialising with each other after school in the park which we know is really hard especially when the weather is nice but we must continue to follow the guidance until it is safe for all.

Hopefully if we all continue to adhere to the governments guidance we will see a further reduction in cases and be able to relax some of these requirements soon.
